## Awards for Licensed Practical Nurses in New Brunswick

### **Collaboration Award**

This excellence as a Team Award honours a group of health care professionals who work in a team setting with LPN(s). This award is given to a health care team that promotes excellence in nursing practice by fostering collaboration with LPNs and support of the ANBLPN. The team creates a climate of professional partnership and collaboration while developing and maintaining therapeutic client centered relationships and a commitment to ongoing professional learning and development.

### **Preceptor Award ( 1 English, 1 French)**

This Excellence as a Preceptor Role honours an LPN who provides exemplary support and mentorship to Practical Nursing students. The recipient consistently demonstrates model practice, leadership and supportive proficiencies, and excellent communication/organizational skills including the aptitude of sharing information professionally and ethically.

### **Professionalism Award**

The Professional Excellence award recognizes commitment as a Practitioner by exhibiting the values and beliefs in health care excellence. The recipient consistently supports and encourages other members of the health care team by modelling a positive attitude toward life and the Practical Nurse Profession. They constantly improve knowledge and skills while demonstrating excellence in nursing practice. They display a constant work ethic as exemplified historically by Audrey Galbraith and Inez Smith and an obligation to public safety and wellbeing.
