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## EMERGENCY STATUS CHANGE: COVID-19 RESPONSE

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Due to the progression of COVID-19 and in the best interest of the public, The Association of New Brunswick Licensed Practical Nurses has developed a rapid response to provide temporary licenses.

There will be no fee for this temporary license, and it will be valid for 4 months. The license may be renewed on an as needed basis; however, this license must be terminated once the COVID-19 pandemic ends.

This special license will be available for Members who hold an Inactive or Non-Practicing license due to retirement or those who have left the profession for reasons other than sick leave, maternity leave or for conduct.

Eligibility requirements include:

- Previous active-practicing license in New Brunswick,
- Active practice within the last 5 years,
- Capacity, competency and character to safely and ethically engage in practice, and
- No outstanding complaints, prohibitions, conditions, agreements or restrictions from any licensing or registration authority (Member in Good Standing)
