On March 1st, 2005, the Discipline and Fitness to Practise Committee met to consider a complaint referred to it by the Complaints Committee concerning a member working in the nursing home sector. The member was terminated by her employer after a lengthy investigation. The allegations included failure to treat residents with dignity; failure to provide the necessary quality of care; verbal aggression and instilling a sense of fear in residents; and unprofessional behaviour. The member denied all the allegations when confronted by her employer. The committee did not find sufficient evidence to support professional misconduct by the member in accordance with paragraph 53(c) of the Act and the matter was dismissed.
