

Application Instructions for Student Registry, Graduate Practical Nurse and CPNRE registration

The Association of New Brunswick Licensed Practical Nurses (ANBLPN) would like to congratulate you on entering the field of nursing. ANBLPN is the professional regulatory authority, who holds legislative responsibility for the registration of Practical Nurses in the province of New Brunswick. Once you have successfully completed the program you will be required to write and pass the Canadian Practical Nurse Registration Exam. (CPNRE).

To help you through the student process, please review the following information to ensure that you remain on track and required documents are submitted to ANBLPN on time to avoid delays.

## FIRST YEAR

### Step 1

- As soon as you start your practical nurse program, go to <https://anblpn.alinityapp.com/client> and click "**signup**".




This will be your account while you are a PN student and will be your account once you become an actively registered member.

### Step 2

- On your account home page complete and submit your **application for Student**.

- You can get back to your account by going to [www.anblpn.ca](http://www.anblpn.ca) and under the PN Student tab click **Login**.

You will require the following documents and you must upload them during the application to student process within **2 months** of the beginning of your program. (you can start the application and save for later to submit if necessary)

1. Current Criminal Record Check from your local police station or online <https://pages.sterlingbackcheck.ca/landing-pages/a/anblpn/>
2. Grade 12 transcript or equivalent (GED) which shows completion of the program pre-requisites. If a pre-requisite is obtained after grade 12(e.g 11 or 12 science) include the transcript for this course as well.
3. Birth Certificate or baptismal certificate
4. Government Photo ID (colour copy of current driver's license or passport)
5. Marriage Certificate or divorce decree if necessary

## New Brunswick Student Practical Nurse Guide

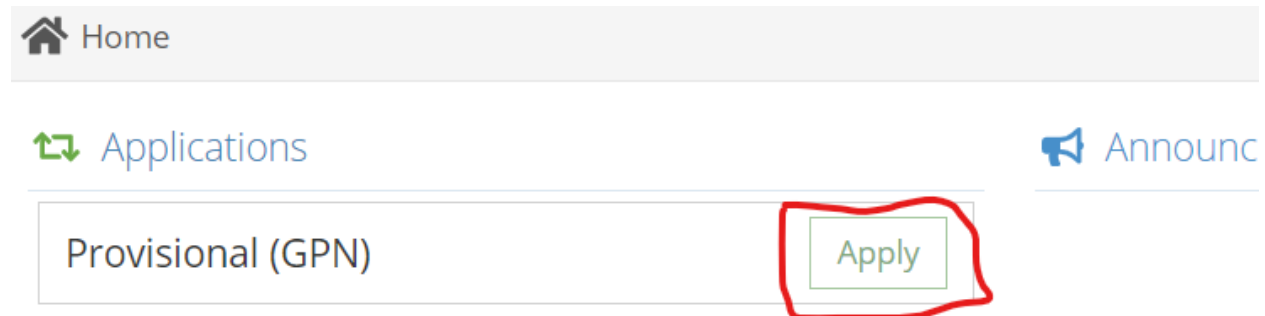
In your **second year** ANBLPN will email you a link and invoice you for your **Jurisprudence Module**. This must be completed BEFORE you can get a Graduate Practical Nurse License or write your Canadian Practical Nurse Registration Exam.

- Please review the Jurisprudence Learning Module Reference Guide before completing the learning module. You must keep **a copy** of your certificate to upload later.
- Obtain your **second Criminal Record Check** from your local police station or online at <https://pages.sterlingbackcheck.ca/landing-pages/a/anblpn/> 2 months prior to your graduation date.

### Step 4

#### Just prior to your graduation date

Go to [www.anblpn.ca](http://www.anblpn.ca) and **Login**. Complete and submit your application for Provisional GPN license.



You will be required to **upload a copy** of your **Jurisprudence certificate** and your second Criminal Record Check and pay the Provisional GPN invoice. Once you graduate and official proof has been received by ANBLPN your Application for your Graduate Practical Nurse License will be approved.

### Step 5

**Once you have a GPN** (Graduate Practical Nurse License) you will then be able to apply and pay for your CPNRE (Canadian Practical Nurse Registration Exam) fees. (approximately \$1000.00)

### Step 6

You will receive an **email from Yardstick** with instructions to book your date and time for your CPNRE and pay for the seat. (\$105.00 plus tax) via ProctorU

Once you have written your CPNRE you will receive your **results by email** from ANBLPN 4-6 weeks after the exam window closes.

**These steps are all important and it is vital that you regularly check your email for communications from ANBLPN/AIAANB.**
